Opener:

What do you hope you will make better, or more of, than your generation before you?

Questions:

1. How did the morality of Ahab compare with kings before him?
2. In light of Deuteronomy 7:1-4 (please read), describe the extent of Ahab's marriage to Jezebel and worship of Baal (16:31).
3. How was Joshua's prophecy fulfilled (16:34) when Jericho was rebuilt?
See Joshua 6:26.
4. Baal was a storm god, supposedly responsible for rain and weather. Discuss the significance of Elijah's pronouncement of a drought (17:1).

Application:

5. Have you ever had a prolonged absence of something specified, or "dry period"? Describe your experience. What have you learned?

There may be some in your group in a "dry period" now. Take a moment to pray in silence for the individuals in your group, and their families, in such a time as this.

6. Have you ever had to speak truth to "power"? Or do you foresee having to do so in the future? Share your experiences in your group.

Take time together to pray that God would be speaking to you, even fortifying you, through this Elijah sermon series.
