What are you waiting for in your life right now?

Questions:

1. What traits do you think Jacob saw in Rachel, other than physical appearance, that were not in Leah?
2. Leah used childbearing to earn Jacob's love and honor. What are the modern ways that people use to make others love them?
3. Why do we want to be loved?
4. In what ways can striving for love be unhealthy competition?
5. At what point in life can we develop self-acceptance and how?
6. Following the sermon, how did God love and honor Leah while Jacob never did?
7. Can you spot other ways God has shown His love for Leah?
