1. Are there certain people of another race that you feel uncomfortable to be friends with? Where does this prejudice come from?
2. What do you thirst for? How do you quench your thirst? Are your solutions temporary or permanent, short-term or long-lasting? Do you feel satisfied? Why or why not?
3. What is it about the way how Jesus communicated the gospel that makes it so effective and universally relevant? What can we learn from his teaching method or evangelism strategy?
4. Jesus said: "You.. worship what you do not know; we worship what we know" (v. 22). To which group do you think you belong?
5. Why is true worship not about a mountain or a particular church or location? How should Christians view traditions, rituals and liturgy in worship?
