Opener:

What is your favorite epic movie, book or game and why?

Questions:

1. What assurances are you given in regard to the judgment carried out (19:11)?
2. How does John describe the one who sat upon the white horse (19:12-13)?
3. At the conclusion of the "thousand years" (20:2-3), what is Satan permitted to do (20:7-9)?
What is his final end (20:10)?

4. Describe the scene of the final judgment as it is reported in 20:11-13. Who is spared from it (20:15)?

Application:

5. What is your current understanding of the purpose of God's judgment?
How has it evolved over the course of the Revelation sermon series (if at all)?
6. Do you see the judgment of Revelation as good news or bad news or both? Why?
7. What are the implications of Christ's title "King of kings" for your life today? How has the reality of Christ as your authority evolved (if at all) throughout the Revelation sermon series?
8. In light of Revelation, are you now viewing your relationships and other daily priorities any different? Discuss.
