



SDG Discussion Guide

Various Scripture Verses

December 13, 2020

Before you begin:

Pray and ask God to enlighten you to show you where he has been at work and present in your past week through events, places, and people. Ask Him to enliven and guide your group in your reading and discussion.

1. What or who are you missing most during this year's Advent, and why?
2. Read Isaiah 9:6 and openly reflect on the meaning of the verse together.
3. Read Luke 2:9 and 2:20. Are you interested or excited to share the story of Jesus with those you interact with in your daily life? What things prevent you from telling others about Jesus?
4. Read Luke 1:46-55. How can you relate to the worship of Mary? Go around in your group and recite or share the great things He has done that cause you to worship.
5. Read Matthew 2:1-2. In what ways are you searching or seeking to worship the Savior this Advent? Even though we may not be in the mood this year because of the pandemic and everything with it, how can you and your group or families be intentional to honor and praise and worship Him? What can you do to "make your trip to the manger?"
6. Luke 1:39-42. The presence of Christ brings leaping, and when we come close to Christ, we will find ourselves in the heart of worship. In what ways can you and your group offer an extravagant physical response to the Lord this year? For example, by singing extra loud, praying extra loud with joy, or literally jumping or leaping with joy?
7. Spend some time in prayer as it flows from your discussion and the Spirit's leading.
